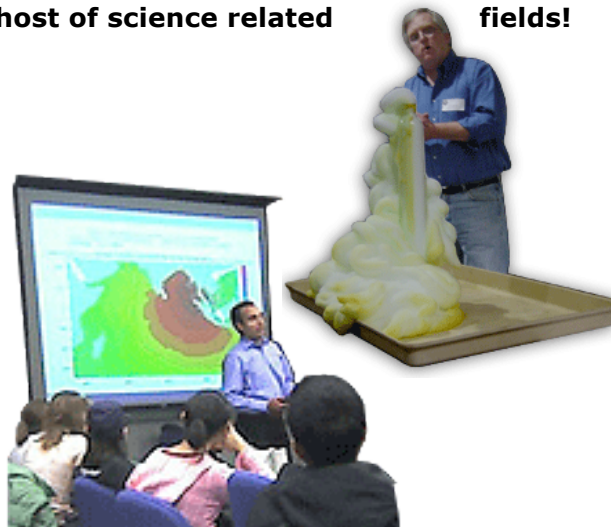
The Best and the Brightest
